

Grade 11 University English: Final Examinations

Final examinations in Grade 11 University English require students to write a comparative essay on the novel and play studied as a class. In order to prepare for the exam students will be provided with one period of class time wherein they will choose from the list of essay topics provided and begin to plan the essay which will be written on the formally scheduled exam day.

All notes and plans will be collected at the end of this preparatory period and returned to students on the day of the examination. No other papers or notes will be permitted on the exam day. The final essay along with all the notes will be submitted at the end of the examination period.

The expectations for this essay will be identical to those of other essays written during the semester. Reviewing the marking criteria, and feedback provided throughout the year would be an appropriate exercise in advance of writing the exam essay.

The following schedule indicates the date of preparation being allotted for each Grade 11 class and the day of the exam. Preparation for the exam will only take place on this date. Absence on this date will require medical documentation for the office if a make-up session is required. In this case, no extra time will be added.
