

STUDENT ACCIDENT INSURANCE

Parents and Guardians, please be aware that the Durham District School Board does **NOT** provide accident insurance coverage for student injuries. Families should recognize that there is always a potential risk of injury with field trips, sports and other student activities both on and off school grounds. Although precautions are taken to ensure the protection of students, accidents can and do happen. Some injuries result in medical, dental or other expenses that are not covered by provincial health care or employer group plans and can be very costly. As a parent or guardian, you become responsible for these expenses.

In accordance with the Education Act we do make available a Student Accident Insurance Program for students. **Participation in this program is voluntary and the costs are to be paid by the parent or guardian.**

For your convenience, we have arranged access to a Student Accident Insurance Policy through **Reliable Life Insurance Company**. This program offers a variety of plans and benefits at **affordable prices**.

Some of the benefits included are:

- dental expenses (resulting from an accident)
- fracture or dislocation
- rehabilitation
- emergency transportation
- total and permanent disability

If your child participates in co-curricular activities or activities outside the school day, there is also a plan tailored to your needs. All rates are one-time annual premiums. The insurance agreement is between **you** and **Reliable Life Insurance Company**.
