



MAKING WHITBY'S SCHOOL ZONES SAFER

DRIVERS AND CYCLISTS

Wait for pedestrians and crossing guards to cross the entire roadway at school crossings before proceeding. **Listen for the Whistles.**

First Whistle: Crossing guard blows the first whistle and enters the intersection, drivers and cyclists must come to a complete stop and remain stopped until the third whistle.

Second Whistle: Crossing guard blows a second whistle once it's safe for students to begin to cross.

Third Whistle: Crossing guard blows a third and final whistle when they are sure the crosswalk is clear of pedestrians.

Drivers and cyclists proceed only when pedestrians and the crossing guard are completely off the road.

STUDENTS

- Pay attention to and follow the crossing guards instructions
- Walk quickly and carefully to the other side of the road
- Stay off bicycles, skateboards, scooters, etc.
- Avoid distractions such as texting or playing with sports equipment
- If you drop something outside of the lines of the crosswalk, leave it. The crossing guard will pick it up
