PATHWAY PROGRAMS 2019-2020

Building Maintenance & Environmental Studies: choose from a term 2 start (Nov. 13) or a term 3 start (Jan. 30)

Enterprising Employee: starts in term 3 (Jan. 30)

Hospitality: starts in term 1 (Sept. 9)

Logistics and Distribution: choose from a term 1 start (Sept. 9) or a term 2 start (Nov. 13)

Office Administration: choose from a term 1 start (Sept. 9) or a term 2 start (Nov. 13)

*Note that Office Administration has two terms of in-class instruction followed by one term of cooperative education. Our other pathway programs consist of one term of instruction followed by one term of cooperative education. Students will be in class Mondays to Fridays from 9 a.m. to 2:30 p.m., with a half hour break for lunch.
