<b>COURSE DESCRIPTION</b>	This course emphasizes the development of writing, reading, critical thinking, and communication skills. Students will be asked to write research papers, correspondence, persuasive essays, and analyse media forms and audiences. An important focus is on establishing appropriate voice and using both business and technical language with precision and clarity.
